Who's Involved?

The Parish Council have formed a committee and are producing a Neighbourhood Plan alongside volunteers which will become part of the guidance for Planning Policies for the village for the next twenty years.

The Group are being guided in their deliberations by Great Yarmouth Strategic Planning Department and hope to secure the services of an Independent Planning Consultant to guide all of us through the process and consultation meetings to produce the Plan for submission.

This work has to be done with parishioner involvement to evolve policies that include the points of view of residents and the final part of the process is a Village Referendum when the whole village will make the decision to go forward or not with the completed plan.

Producing the Plan is a complex procedure, and a considerable amount of work will be involved, but the current Parish Council consider the effort will be worth while and will allow residents of Hemsby to influence the planning process in our in a structured way which hopefully will improve our built environment.

Over the next few months there will be a series of 'Pop Up Sessions' at the Parish Office where residents can discuss the evolving plans.
